NO DAY ENTRIES

ENTRIES CLOSE

5pm Tuesday 5th March 2019 – Series & Rnd 1 & Rnd 2.

There will be a minimum of 8 prepaid entries for a class to exist, and a maximum of 30 riders for mini classes and a maximum of 25 riders for the Junior 85cc classes.

Classes are open for Canterbury Mini MX Club members first, then if places still available will be open for non members. Entries and starting spots are only confirmed once entry payment has been received.

TIMING TECH – TRANSPONDERS

Lap-scoring will be by Electronic Transponder System supplied by Timing Tech for all classes except the Non Competition class which is not being lapsed.

MNZ LICENCE

Riders must hold a current MNZ Licence and must present that licence along with a current club membership at sign in OR purchase a one event licence for \$30.00 (all riders must provide proof of MNZ affiliated club membership or join the Host Club).

One Event Licence:

In the absence of holding a MNZ Licence, competitors may apply for a One Event Licence. All riders must adhere to all rules as per the Manual of Motorcycle Sport

(see www.mnz.co.nz) & the supplementary regulations:

Not limited too but including:

Competitor has no medical condition that prevents them from safely participating in this event & has not suffered from concussion or had a head injury in the last three weeks.

Their motorcycle is in a safe operating condition and type suited to this event, (all side stands must be removed).

One Event Licences must be completed in full at sign-in before **participating** in any part of the event and must be signed by the competitor and if under 18years of age counter signed by a Parent or Guardian

RACE FORMAT

The Clerk of Course & Secretary reserve the right to change or alter classes if necessary. Some classes may have a split start. Depending on entries received by closing date (1st March 2019) and weather permitting – 4 races per round + practice

LIVE TIMING

Available via Race-Monitor, CTAS, or Mylaps app's subject to sufficient internet coverage.

START

Will be a clutch start behind backward falling gates.

BIKE & BACK NUMBERS

Correct racing numbers are to be worn on the back of body armour or jersey & on bike as per rule 10.2.

REFUNDS

Refunds of entry fees will be as per rule 5.5a.

TRACK/PIT RULES

Camping Permitted @ \$20 per family per night (pay at event)

No quad or pit bikes, no riding in Pits without a helmet
No tear offs and No dogs, No Alcohol – No exceptions

INSPECTION

Random technical inspection as per rule 10.1

No motorcycle at any event shall exceed the stipulated noise emission level of 96dBA as per rule 10.6a.

Series Trophies to 10th for all competition classes.
Participation Medals/trophies for all other riders. Prize Giving to be held at the Darfield Rugby Club after round 5

POINTS SCALE – For all races (Rule 6.14a)

Points awarded as FIM System. In the event of a tie, overall result will be based on count back as per Rule 6.7a.
1st 25; 2nd 22; 3rd 20; 4th 18; 5th 16; 6th 15; 7th 14; 8th 13; 9th 12; 10th 11; 11th 10; 12th 9; 13th 8; 14th 7; 15th 6; 16th 5; 17th 4; 18th 3; 19th 2; 20th 1

Part points will be allocated to those from 21st position.

For overall series results – the worst round result for each competitor will be dropped, ie the best results from 4 of the 5 rounds will be combined for the overall series points.
