All motorcycles are to be presented within regulation for their class as per chapter 10 MNZ MOM and if seen to be non-compliant to be subject to a technical inspection as per rule 10.1b under the guide of rule 6.19

For any reasons of Force Majeure, should a meeting or part of a meeting be cancelled, any entry fee refunds will only be made at the sole discretion of the organizers. The organizers reserve the right to alter the meeting format/race duration as may be deemed necessary.
