ENTRIES

Entry fees

\$130.00 Mini / Junior / Seniors (includes transponder hire)

- Mini licenced riders not permitted to double class

Entries not completed in full and/or without entry fee will NOT be accepted.

No Entries will be accepted on the day.

\$100.00 Late entry fee will be enforced; entry and payment must be received by 5pm Monday 20th May. Late entries only accepted at the discretion of the organisers.

Note: Because of the number of classes some are being split start. Any classes indicated with a split start will be closed when a maximum of 30 prepaid entries are received for both the applicable classes. For other classes if more than 40 entries (30 for mini's) are received for a class before closing, the first 40 (30 mini) prepaid entries will be accepted. More than 40 entries may be accepted for MX2 and if so qualifying will be held.

ENTRIES CLOSE

Monday 20th May 2018 5pm sharp !

Some classes may be closed earlier if full (see above).

There will be a **minimum of 8 prepaid entries** for a class to exist, and a maximum of 40 (30 Minis) riders per class. * Exception; if more than 40 entries are received for MX2 then qualifying will be held with non-qualifiers moving to MX3.

Note: No Entries will be accepted on the day

Should any junior classes be split start then as per rule 15.21a there will be a maximum of a 30 gate start.

TIMING TECH – TRANSPONDERS

Lap-scoring will be by Timing Tech using Mylaps Electronic Transponder system for all classes.

SIGN ON & RIDERS BRIEFING

6.30am – 7.30am Saturday only.

Riders briefing 7.45am both days sharp in your gear

Friday afternoon sign on at the track – time TBA

RACE FORMAT

The organisers reserve the right to change or alter classes if necessary. Some classes may have a split start. Depending on entries received by closing date 20th May and weather permitting – Saturday 3 rounds – Sun 2 rounds plus feature races.

Mini's – Saturday 4 rounds – Sunday 3 rounds + Feature Race.

MNZ LICENCE

Riders must hold a current MNZ Licence and must present that licence along with a current club at sign in OR purchase a one event licence (minimum age 4yrs & over) for \$30.00 (does not include club membership)

One Event Licence:

In the absence of holding a MNZ Licence, competitors may apply for a One Event Licence. All riders must adhere to all rules as per the Manual of Motorcycle Sport

(see www.mnz.co.nz) & the supplementary regulations:

Not limited too but including:

Competitor has no medical condition that prevents them from safely participating in this event & has not suffered from concussion or had a head injury in the last three weeks.

Their motorcycle is in a safe operating condition and type suited to this event, (all side stands must be removed).

One Event Licences must be completed in full at sign-in before **participating** in any part of the event and must be signed by the competitor and if under 18years of age counter signed by a Parent or Guardian.

SAFETY GEAR:

All competitors must have the correct safety gear and protective clothing as per rules 8.1 and 8.1c, & 8.1e including Body Armour – commercially available Motorcycle Body Protection (Armour) that must include back protection.

Safety Helmets – as per rules 8.2 & 8.2a-8.2n and Helmet details must be shown in the appropriate section in the riders logbook. Boots as per rule 8.3 & 8.3b.



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LIVE TIMING

Subject to sufficient coverage, via Race-Monitor & Mylaps Apps. More info available on www.timingtech.co.nz

START

Will be a clutch start behind backward falling gates.

BIKE & BACK NUMBERS

Correct racing numbers are to be worn on the back of body armour or jersey & on bike as per rule 10.2.

REFUNDS

Refunds of entry fees will be as per rule 5.5a.

TRACK/PIT RULES

Pit bikes – Under no circumstance will pit bikes be permitted at the event

No dogs – No exceptions.

No tear offs – No exceptions.

No push bikes around the track, pit area only.

ALCOHOL

The use of alcohol is not permitted as per rules 6.20.1.

INSPECTION

Random technical inspection as per rule 6.19 & 10.1

No motorcycle at any event shall exceed the stipulated noise emission level of 96dBA as per rule 10.6a.

FORCE MAJEURE CLAUSE

For any reasons of Force Majeure, should a meeting or part of a meeting be cancelled, any entry fee refunds will only be made at the sole discretion of the organizers. The COC/Secretary reserve the right to alter the meeting format/race duration as may be deemed necessary.

POINTS SCALE – For all races

Points awarded as FIM System. Part points will be used from 21st place. In the event of a tie, overall result will be based on count back as per Rule 6-7a.
