SIGN ON & RIDERS BRIEFING

Mini – 7.00-7.30am

Juniors – 8.15-8.45am

Senior – 9.15-11.00am

Riders briefing time will be advised at sign in for each group.

FORMAT

Mini Trailride (Under 12 years) – The competitor shall be accompanied by a parent or guardian who shall shadow rider throughout the entire course (need to wear a fluoro vest). Accompanying rider must also sign a disclaimer at sign in.

Non competitive/Not lapscored

Course shall approx. 5km, finish flag at 45 minutes.

All riders must be able to pick up their own machine unaided as per rule 13.22.

Juniors

Junior Club class 10-16 years old.

Course approx. 10km, finish flag at 1 ½ hours.

Junior maximum capacity is 200cc 2 stroke & 300cc 4 stroke.

10-12 year olds may only ride 65-85cc 2 stroke & upto 150cc 4 stroke.

All riders must be able to pick up their own machine unaided as per rule 13.22.

Seniors

Course approx. 20km, finish flag at 3 hours.

RULES

NO DOGS/NO TEAR OFFS

Rules on track marking and penalties as per MNZ RULE BOOK Chapter 13 CROSS COUNTRY

13.3 Track marking: Riders **must** pass within 10 meters of an arrow. Where red and white pegs are used riders **must** stay within the pegs.

13.3a Failure to follow markers : Will result in a Stop/Go penalty being imposed by a meeting official, such penalty shall not exceed 5 minutes

Start – Shot gun Le Mans start

BIKE & BACK NUMBERS

All bikes must have front/side numbers as per 10.3a.

REFUNDS

Refunds of entry fees will be as per rule 5.5

LICENCE REQUIREMENTS - SUPPORT/CLUB CLASSES

Riders must hold a current MNZ Club or Championship Licence & Club Membership, OR apply for a One Event Licence (\$30) - (includes Club membership for this event)

One Event Licence

In the absence of holding a MNZ Licence, competitors may apply for a One Event Licence. All riders must adhere to all rules as per the Manual of Motorcycle Sport (see www.mnz.co.nz) & the supplementary regulations: Not limited too but including:

Competitor has no medical condition that prevents them from safely participating in this event & has not suffered from concussion or had a head injury in the last three weeks. Their motorcycle is in a safe operating condition and type suited to this event, (all side stands must be removed).

One Event Licences must be completed in full at sign-in before **participating** in any part of the event and must be signed by the competitor and if under 18years of age counter signed by a Parent or Guardian.

MINIMUM SAFETY STANDARDS MUST BE ADHERED TO

Helmet (approved standard), goggles, body armour with back protection, gloves, long pants & boots, as per 8.1. & 8.1c & helmets as rule 8i.2a & 8.2n. Bikes must comply with rule 10. Note: Helmet Camera's are not permitted.
