Thanks for supporting this event, if you are competing this weekend please read information below relating to this event.

Venue – Entrance is now at 343 Inwoods Road, Southbridge (best entrance to paddock)

NOTE: Every competitor must present their MNZ Club membership affiliation card - otherwise you will be required to join the Christchurch Off-Road Motorcycle Club on the day.

COVID 19

If you have any symptoms or are unwell please stay away from the event. Including the flu, coughs or colds etc. Each rider is permitted to have one support person or pit crew only. There are no exceptions to this. This is to keep our numbers under 500 as per the Health Department and Government guidelines.

Absolutely no spectators under any circumstances.

We have a sound system for riders briefing, we encourage everyone to keep their 2m distancing, this applies for sign in also please.

We will have officials enforcing these rules. Unfortunately if the rules are broken this will put the whole event in jeopardy and you will be asked to leave.

As you are aware this is completely out of the norm, but we are trying to make things as normal as possible so everyone can have fun on their motorbikes.

Further to this, restrictions on members returning from overseas or overseas based members will come into effect immediately. This will require all members that have been overseas, entering and or having returned to New Zealand must adhere to the New Zealand Ministry of Health policy before attending any MNZ Event. TRACK/PIT RULES

NO DOGS (Please ensure you pass this onto anyone coming to support you)

CAMPING ALLOWED

NO TEAR OFFS ALLOWED

All bikes must be numbered so that easily identifiable for Officials' & Flag Marshall's.

Please ensure you go out in the correct practice/race and if your race is split start ensure you start with the correct group.

Coffee & Food will be available to purchase onsite so bring along some cash.

Take your rubbish home with you.

If you have been injured or referred for follow up treatment at an event you will be listed on the MNZ restricted riders list & will require a Medical Clearance before you are eligible to compete again – any queries relating to this please contact the MNZ office.

SIGN IN -

Saturday Sign in: 6.30-7.30am

Sunday 7.00-7.30am (Only for those who did not sign in on Saturday)

Anyone not competing both days please ensure you return your transponder and pick up your licence before leaving the event.

For those needing a One Event Licence, please complete the paperwork for this before signing in and getting a transponder (separate que), & if you are under 18 years the One Event Licence needs to be counter signed by a Parent or Guardian.

All competitors including those purchasing a One Event Licence must present their club membership card (must be a MNZ affiliated club – or purchase membership with the Christchurch Off-Road Motorcycle Club.

PRIZEGIVING

At the track – 30 minutes after completion of last feature race

HELMETS – You need to take your helmet/(s) along to sign in.

We don't want to turn anyone away on the day, so please check in advance that your helmet meets current MNZ regulations.

As of 31st December 2019 the Snell approval code of M2010 can no longer be accepted, M2000 or M2005 are also not accepted.

Helmet standards are found either on a label on the chin strap, a sticker inside the lining of the helmet, or on the outside rear helmet at the base.

An example of what the Helmet Standards look like is provided at the end of these regulations.

Note: Rule 8.2n: 'Helmet Cameras or other accessories are not permitted to be attached to the rider's Helmet'. (This includes Camera Mounts)

Body Armour – Body Armour that includes back protection must be worn and will be checked on the day.

If caught without body armour you will not be able to compete.

Our Officials & Organisers are all volunteers without whom this and other events couldn't happen, they don't set the regulations but are required to enforce them.
