COVID-19 LEVEL 2 REQUIREMENTS & GUIDELINES

Main points to note are:

- **If you or a member of your household are unwell, please do NOT attend the event and follow Government recommendations around getting tested and isolating.**
- **Strict gate opening hours are in place. Please respect these.**
- **Gates opening hours are 7.00am on both days and will be closed at 9.00am on both days.**
- Access outside these hours is only available for personnel involved in the running of the event (to scan in on entry) and by prior arrangement.
- Everyone must complete contact tracing coming into the event – please help speed this process up by having the QR App on your phone (one scan per family/residence within each vehicle), there will be plenty of QR codes spread around the event and we do encourage everyone with the QR App on their phone to scan once inside the event area. You will need to scan each time you enter the event venue. Please ensure Bluetooth is activated on your phone, this helps keep track of people you've been near.
- No spectators, although not limited to a specific number you are asked to minimize pit crew attending where possible.
- Spread out around the pit area and practice social distancing (minimum 2m) from other rider's pits.
- **Remember your Face Mask.** Face Masks are strongly recommended except for competitors while racing. **Face Masks are compulsory at sign in & in the start area.** If for any reason a briefing is needed the loudspeaker will be used and you are asked to attend wearing a Face Mask. Please ensure you practice social distancing (2m separation) with others when outside your pit.
- **A written riders briefing is attached (a shortened briefing at the event is scheduled), it is compulsory for you to read and agree to abide by this.** If you have any questions you are asked to direct these to the club via email secretary@chch.nz by 7pm on Thursday 18th November 2021. A rider's rep for each track has been nominated, if you have any objection to the person nominated you are required to contact the club via email secretary@chchmx.nz by 7pm Thursday 18th November 2021. Each morning Club Officials will be available at the sign in area for you to approach with anything that has arisen and you feel needs discussed. A loud speaker will be used for communication at the event.

FACEMASKS & SOCIAL DISTANCING IS COMPULSORY

For those needing a One Event Licence, please complete the paperwork for this (separate que) before signing in and getting a transponder, the One Event Licence needs to be signed by a Parent or Guardian. Bring your helmet with you to sign in. All competitors including those riding on a One Event Licence need to produce proof of current club membership, failure to do so will mean you will need to join the Christchurch Off-Road Motorcycle Club at the event.

TRACK/PIT RULES

NO DOGS (Please ensure you pass this onto anyone coming to support you)

NO TEAR OFFS ALLOWED

CAMPING ALLOWED

All bikes must be numbered so that easily identifiable for Officials' & Flag Marshall's.

Please ensure you go out in the correct practice/race and if your race is split start ensure you start with the correct group.

Coffee & Food will be available to purchase onsite so bring along some cash.

Take your rubbish home with you.

If you have been injured or referred for follow up treatment at an event you will be listed on the MNZ restricted riders list & will require a Medical Clearance before you are eligible to compete again – any queries relating to this please contact the MNZ office.

HELMETS – You need to take your helmet/(s) along to sign in.

We don't want to turn anyone away on the day, so please check in advance that your helmet meets current MNZ regulations.

As of 1st January 2020 the Snell approval code of M2010 along with M2000 or M2005 can no longer be accepted.

Helmet standards are found either on a label on the chin strap, a sticker inside the lining of the helmet, or on the outside rear helmet at the base.

An example of what the Helmet Standards look like is provided at the end of these regulations.

Note: Rule 8.2n: 'Helmet Cameras or other accessories are not permitted to be attached to the rider's Helmet'. (This includes Camera Mounts)

Body Armour – Body Armour that includes back protection must be worn and will be checked on the day.

If caught without body armour you will not be able to compete.

Our Officials & Organisers are all volunteers without whom this and other events couldn't happen, they don't set the regulations but are required to enforce them.

PRIZEGIVING – At the track 30 minutes after completion of the last race.
