As this event is a Mini & Junior Event on the same track, due to time restrictions Non Comp Class not available for this event

ENTRIES CLOSE

5pm Monday 26th Aug 2024.

There will be a minimum of 8 prepaid entries for a class to exist, and a maximum of 30 riders for mini classes and a **maximum of 30 riders** for the Junior 85cc classes.

BIKE & BACK NUMBERS

Correct racing numbers are recommended to be worn on the back of body armour or jersey & on bike as per rule 10.2.

START

Will be a clutch start behind backward falling gates.

MNZ LICENCE

Riders must hold a current MNZ Licence and must present that licence along with a current club membership at sign in OR purchase a one event licence for \$40.00 (all riders must provide proof of MNZ affiliated club membership or join the Host Club).

One Event Licence:

In the absence of holding a MNZ Licence, competitors may apply for a One Event Licence. All riders must adhere to all rules as per the Manual of Motorcycle Sport (see www.mnz.co.nz) & the supplementary regulations: Not limited too but including:
Competitor has no medical condition that prevents them from concussion or had a head injury in the last three weeks.
Their motorcycle is in a safe operating condition and type suited to this event, (all side stands must be removed).
One Event Licences must be completed in full at sign-in before **participating** in any part of the event and must be signed by the competitor and if under 18years of age counter signed by a Parent or Guardian

RACE FORMAT

The Clerk of Course & Secretary reserve the right to change or alter classes if necessary. Some classes may have a split start. Depending on entries received by closing date 26th Aug 2024) and weather permitting – minimum of 5 races over the weekend + practice each day.

All classes compete on the same track.

Mini's may compete in a Junior class from 8 years as per MOM 15.12.

Note: 85cc class competitors

Must choose one age group - not permitted to double class in both 8-12 year 85cc & Under 17 year 85cc classes.

REFUNDS

Refunds of entry fees will be as per rule 5.5a.

TRACK/PIT RULES

No Camping sorry.

**No quad or pit bikes, no riding in Pits without a helmet
No tear offs and No dogs, No Alcohol – No exceptions**

INSPECTION

Random technical inspection as per rule 10.1

Part points will be allocated to those from 21st position.

Junior Under 17 years 85cc (60-85cc 2 stroke & 100-150cc 4 stroke) * Note: competitors not permitted to double class in both 85cc classes		
Junior 12-16 years 125/250cc (90-150cc 2 stroke & 14-16 years 250cc 4 st) * Minimum 14 years to ride 250cc 4 stroke or 150cc 2 stroke
