ENTRIES CLOSE

20th September 2021.

There will be a minimum of 8 prepaid entries for a class to exist, and a maximum of 40 riders per class Senior/Junior & a maximum of 30 riders per class for Mini's.

Late entry fee will be enforced; entry and payment must be received by 20th September 2021. Late entries only accepted at the discretion of the organisers & if accepted a late fee will apply.

NO DAY ENTRIES. ENTRIES MUST BE PREPAID

TIMING TECH – TRANSPONDERS

Lap-scoring will be by Electronic Transponder System supplied by Timing Tech for all classes.

MNZ LICENCE

Riders must hold a current MNZ Licence and must present that licence along with a current club membership at sign in OR purchase a one event licence (minimum age 4yrs & over) for \$30.00 (includes Event club membership)

RACE FORMAT

The organisers reserve the right to change or alter classes if necessary. Some classes may have a split start. Depending on entries received by closing date (20th Sep 2021) and weather /time permitting – 3 races per class followed by Junior & Senior Feature races - (Main Track), Mini's there will be a maximum 5 races per class.

REFUNDS

Refunds of entry fees will be as per rule 5.5a.

START

Will be a clutch start behind backward falling gates.

BIKE & BACK NUMBERS

Correct racing numbers are to be worn on the back of body armour or jersey & on bike as per rule 10.2.

TRACK/PIT RULES

Pit bikes – Under no circumstance will pit bikes be permitted at the event. **No dogs/No Tear Offs – No exceptions**

INSPECTION

Random technical inspection as per rule 10.1

No motorcycle at any event shall exceed the stipulated noise emission level of 96dBA as per rule 10.6a.

FORCE MAJEURE CLAUSE

For any reasons of Force Majeure, should a meeting or part of a meeting be cancelled, any entry fee refunds will only be made at the sole discretion of the organizers. The organizers reserve the right to alter the meeting format/race duration as may be deemed necessary.

POINTS SCALE – For all races (Rule 6.14a)

Points awarded as FIM System. In the event of a tie, overall result will be based on count back as per Rule 6.7a.

2. I am aware that the sport of Motorcycle Competition might a) cause me injury; serious or otherwise b) damage my property.
3. I wish to take part in the **South Canterbury Champs** despite the above risks.
4. Neither I, or anyone associated or connected with me will make any claim against you or your officers, employees or agents in respect of: a) any injury suffered by me; or b) any damage to any of my property regardless of how the injury or damage occurs.
5. I will indemnify you against all claims, damages or losses (including costs) which you incur as the direct or indirect result of any injury to me or damage to my property.
6. I am physically fit and there is no health or other reason why I should not participate in the sport of Motorcycle Competition.
7. I am aware that this disclaimer will not affect any legal obligations you have to me which you cannot contract out of under NZ Law.

I acknowledge that attending riders briefing is compulsory

It is a condition of entry that all person having any connection with promotion, organisation, and conduct of the event including land owners, will be absolved from any liability out of any accident however caused and resulting in damage to property and or in respect of death or personal injury.

UPDATED MNZ LEVEL 2 COVID-19 EVENT MANAGEMENT REQUIREMENTS

Entries

Online pre-entry & payment recommended.

Officials

Face masks **MUST** be worn in all common use/close contact areas. It is recommended gloves to also be worn.

Compliance Official. A minimum of one Compliance Official to ensure that all MNZ Covid-19 Level 2 Event Management requirements are monitored and adhered to throughout the event.

Masks

Masks **recommended** to be worn at all times by everyone attending event (except competitors during race).

Entrance

Entrance personnel **MUST** wear face mask & gloves.

All entrances/access points **MUST** be manned for entire duration of event.

Contact tracing **MUST** take place at each entrance/access point (Covid19 App & manual options)

Contact tracing of all Volunteers, Contractors, Participants (Riders) & their Crew that enter the event (to include arrival time)

* No limit on number of above attending event

Pitting

All pits must strictly adhere to a minimum of 2 metre distance from each other.

Sign in

2 metre distance markings must be in place for queuing at each sign in table.

All sign in personnel **MUST** wear face mask and gloves.

Steward/Helmet & gear checking personnel – **MUST** wear face masks & gloves during this process

Bike check – Examiners **MUST** wear face masks & gloves.

Riders Briefing

Copy to be emailed to all competitors prior to event or placed on club website/social media site.

Public address system in Pit area to aid riders briefing and manage communication throughout the event.

Social distancing of 2 metres during riders briefing.

Start Area

Start Personnel **MUST** wear face masks.

Maximum 1 crew member per rider within start area (minimise time within area). **MUST** wear face mask.

Rider must keep helmet on at all times.

Toilets

Minimum of 1 toilet per 50 attendees

2 metre distance markings must be in place for queuing outside each toilet.

Food Providers

2 metre distance markings must be in place for queuing.

SPECTATORS – NOT PERMITTED AT THIS EVENT.
