\$80 Minis (all other mini classes, transponder hire included)
\$120 Junior/Seniors classes (transponder hire included)
Entries not completed in full and/or without entry fee will not be accepted.
\$50.00 Late entry fee will be enforced; entry and payment must be received by 5pm Friday 26th January. Late entries only accepted at the discretion of the organisers.
Entries not confirmed until payment received, once classes are full any additional entries will go on a waiting list and affected competitors will be notified via email.

ENTRIES CLOSE

Friday 26th January at 5pm.
Some classes may be closed earlier if full.
There will be a **minimum of 8 prepaid entries** for a class to run, and a maximum of 40 (30 Minis) riders per class.
(Exception: Jnr 125cc & Jnr 250cc classes split start with a combined maximum of 40 competitors)
Some classes will be split start with another class.
Note: Day Entries are subject to class space availability & \$50 late fee.

TIMING TECH – TRANSPONDERS

Lap-scoring will be by Timing Tech using Mylaps Electronic Transponder system for all lapscored classes.

RACE FORMAT

The COC & Race Secretary reserve the right to change or alter classes if necessary. Some classes may have a split start. Any Mini's wanting to ride 65cc on the main track can enter the appropriate 85cc class, an additional 65cc class will not be run on the main track.

Main Track: Saturday 3 rounds & Sunday 2 rounds plus *King of Nuggets Feature Race.*

Mini Track: Saturday 5 rounds & Sunday 4 rounds
* Depending on entries received by closing date (26th January) and weather/time permitting.

MINI CLASS ENTRIES ARE NOT PERMITTED TO DOUBLE CLASS

MNZ LICENCE

Riders must hold a current MNZ Licence and must present that licence along with a current club at sign in OR purchase a one event licence (minimum age 4yrs & over) for \$30.00 (does not include club membership)

One Event Licence:

In the absence of holding a MNZ Licence, competitors may apply for a One Event Licence. All riders must adhere to all rules as per the Manual of Motorcycle Sport (see www.mnz.co.nz) & the supplementary regulations: Not limited too but including:
Competitor has no medical condition that prevents them from safely participating in this event & has not suffered from concussion or had a head injury in the last three weeks.
Their motorcycle is in a safe operating condition and type suited to this event, (all side stands must be removed).
One Event Licences must be completed in full at sign-in before **participating** in any part of the event and must be signed by the competitor and if under 18years of age counter signed by a Parent or Guardian.

SAFETY GEAR:

All competitors must have the correct safety gear and protective clothing as per rules 8.1 and 8.1c, & 8.1e including Body Armour – commercially available Motorcycle Body Protection (Armour) that must include back protection.
Safety Helmets – as per rules 8.2 & 8.2a-8.2n and Helmet details must be shown in the appropriate section in the rider's logbook. Boots as per rule 8.3 & 8.3b.

FLAGS

Any Yellow Flag incident whether it be passing or jumping under the Yellow Flag will result in a two place relegation and a possible fine.

MISSING PEGS

Riders who miss pegs must return to the track as soon as it is safely possible without gaining an advantage, race position or damaging track markings. Should an advantage or gain in race position happen from the incident, or damage be done to the circuit markings while returning, the rider may be penalised as per rule 6.10a.

Subject to sufficient coverage, via CTAS & Speedhive App. More info available on www.timingtech.co.nz

START

Will be a clutch start behind backward falling gates.

Starters Orders (rule 6.6i)

Once you enter the start area you are under the 'Starters' complete control. What they say goes, this applies to gate picks, positions and start procedures.

BIKE & BACK NUMBERS

Correct racing numbers are recommended to be worn on the back of body armour or jersey. Bike numbers as per MOM 10.2a.

REFUNDS

Refunds of entry fees will be as per rule 5.5a.

TRACK/PIT RULES

Pit bikes – Under no circumstance will pit bikes be permitted at the event

No dogs – No exceptions.

No tear offs – No exceptions.

No push bikes around the track, pit area only.

Riders are responsible for behaviour of Pit Crew & rider & crew will be asked to leave if deemed necessary.

ALCOHOL & DRUGS

The use of alcohol & drugs is not permitted as per rules 6.20.

INSPECTION

Random technical inspection as per rule 6.19 & 10.1

No motorcycle at any event shall exceed the stipulated noise emission level of 96dBA as per rule 10.6a.

CAMPING AT TRACK

Camping is available at the track for a fee of \$20 per site per night to be paid with entry.

FORCE MAJEURE CLAUSE

For any reasons of Force Majeure, should a meeting or part of a meeting be cancelled, any entry fee refunds will only be made at the sole discretion of the organizers. The COC/Race Secretary reserve the right to alter the meeting format/race duration as may be deemed necessary.

POINTS SCALE – For all races (6.14a)

Points awarded as FIM System. Part points will be used from 21st place. In the event of a tie, overall result will be based on count back as per Rule 6.7a.

1st 25; 2nd 22; 3rd 20; 4th 18; 5th 16; 6th 15; 7th 14; 8th 13; 9th 12; 10th 11; 11th 10; 12th 9; 13th 8; 14th 7; 15th 6; 16th 5; 17th 4; 18th 3; 19th 2; 20th 1

Prizegiving will be held immediately following the completion of the Feature Races.

Trophies to 3rd place for all classes except Mini Non Comp Participation awards for all minis.
