### **TRACK/PIT RULES**

**NO DOGS – NO TEAR OFF’S - NO PIT BIKES – NO EXCEPTIONS YOU WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE!**

All bikes must be numbered (**front & side plates**) so that they are easily identifiable for Officials’ & Flag Marshall’s & commentator.

Please ensure you go out in the correct practice/race and if your race is split start ensure you start with the correct group.

A big thanks to the Stackhouse’s for the use of their property, please respect this and ensure you either take your rubbish home or put in the bins provided. Hot food & coffee van onsite so bring along some cash.

Please note spectators will be charged an entry fee when they arrive after 8am, \$10 per adult, Under 15 free, \$20 Per Car Load. Fees are per day.

**NO PITTING BEFORE 3PM FRIDAY**

Please keep clear of lanes/access roads which have been bunted off & also areas bunted off for Major Sponsors (these will be clearly marked). Lots of space for pitting in the rest of the paddock.

### **SIGN IN**

**6.30am - 8.00am – Saturday** at the Track

**6.30am - 8.00am – Bike check** (Pit side of creek – right next to creek crossing) for those riding on a One Event Licence & all first time competitors).

Please ensure that your MNZ log book is completed, with current helmet details in the front section & current Club membership card easily visible.

For those that require a One Event Licence you will need to complete the paperwork for this (separate que at sign on) before signing in and collecting your transponder. You will also need to get your bike ‘checked’ and will be sent additional information regarding this. If you arrive late you may be excluded from participating.

### **PRIZEGIVING**

To be held at the end of the day on Sunday at the track, once both tracks have been packed down.

**HELMETS** – You need to take your helmet/(s) along to sign in.

**We don’t want to turn anyone away on the day, so please check in advance that your helmet meets current MNZ regulations.**

As of 31<sup>st</sup> December 2019 the Snell approval code of M2000, M2005 & M2010 can no longer be accepted.

Helmet standards are found either on a label on the chin strap, a sticker inside the lining of the helmet, or on the outside rear helmet at the base.

Please ensure you have the correct safety gear; regulations around Safety Gear can be found the following link at: <https://mnz.co.nz/wp-content/uploads/2021/07/Chapter-8-Safety-Gear-Off-Road.pdf>

An example of what the Helmet Standards look like is provided at the end of these regulations.

**Note: Rule 8.2n:** ‘Helmet Cameras or other accessories are not permitted to be attached to the rider’s Helmet’. (This includes Camera Mounts)

**Body Armour** – Body Armour that includes back protection must be worn and will be checked on the day.

Our Officials & Organisers are all volunteers without whom this and other events couldn’t happen, they don’t set the regulations but are required to enforce them.
